







## Standard .Zip Tournament elo <2400

The tournament will be held from Friday, October 17 to Sunday, October 19, 2025 at the headquarters of the Società Scacchistica Triestina, 16 Trento Street on the second floor, according to the following schedule:

Friday, October 17 by 4:30 p.m. - Registration confirmation

Friday, October 17 at 5:00 p.m. - First round

Saturday, October 18 at 10:00 a.m. - Second round

Saturday, October 18 at 2:30 p.m. - Third round

Sunday, October 19 at 10:00 a.m. - Fourth round

Sunday, October 19 at 2:30 p.m. - Fifth round

Sunday, October 19 at the end of the last round - prize giving

Pairings will be made following the FIDE variant of Swiss tournaments using Swiss Manager software. The thinking time will be 60' from the start of the game plus 15' at move 40, with 15" increment at each move starting at move 1. In case of a tie, Buchholz, Buchholz Cut1, Sonneborn-Berger and APRO will be considered in order for technical tie-breaker purposes.

## Registrations

Participation fee: 40 euros

Registration fees must be paid by bank transfer made out to Società Scacchistica Triestina (IBAN IT 92 H 02008 02230 000005435046). After payment contact the Society's Secretariat by e-mail at sst1904@sst1904.com to formalize registration. Otherwise payments will be accepted at the venue.

## **Prizes**

Prizes are not cumulative or divisible. In case of a tie they will be awarded by technical tie-breaker. In case a player is entitled to more than one payout he will receive the one with the higher amount.

First overall: 120 euros

Second overall: 90 euros

Third overall: 50 euros

First with Elo < 1700: 40 euros

Prizes will be paid by bank transfer, so winners must provide their bank details. It will also be necessary to submit the beneficiary's tax code and, for minors, the declaration and tax code of the person exercising parental authority.

## Regulations

The tournament is open to all players with elo less than 2400. Italian players in possession of FSI competitive or junior membership for the year or foreign players in possession of FIN may participate in the tournament.

Any player admissions to the second round will be accepted with an initial ranking score of zero

Any player not present at their chessboard within 30' minutes of the start of the game will forfeit the match.

Bringing electronic devices into the playing venue is prohibited. Violators will forfeit the match.

Arbitration decisions are final.

By registering, the player accepts what is contained in the present notice - to which the organization reserves the right to make any changes that may be necessary for the best outcome of the event - and authorizes, in accordance with Law 675/96, the processing and dissemination of information related to the tournament, both personal and related to matches and results, and photos and images. (For minors, acceptance of the notice and authorization for the processing of data and photos is given by the parent or guardian who registers them for the tournament.)

For anything not covered by this notice/rules, the FIDE/FSI technical rules valid at the time the event is held shall apply.
